age of forty, his book *Eureka* was published. In it, he weaved together his scientific speculations about the universe with his own literary theory, theology, and philosophy of science. Although Poe himself considered it to be his magnum opus, *Eureka* has mostly been overlooked or underappreciated, sometimes even to the point of being thought an elaborate hoax.
