The problems in *Education Law: A Problem-Based Approach* are all drawn to be current and immediately relevant. The case and statutory and regulatory materials support this approach by including the classic Supreme Court cases such as *Brown v. Board of Education*, *Rowley*, *T.L.O.*, and the speech trilogy, along with the recent decisions by the Court such as *Safford Unified Sch. Dist. v. Redding*, *Forest Grove Sch. Dist. v.
